### LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT

Thomas and my niece, Helen Irene Thomas, the same to be theirs absolutely.

ITEM 6: I hereby nominate and appoint my husband, James S. Taylor as Executor of this my Will and request the court to appoint him as such without bond, if he be living at the time of my decease, if he should not be living, then I nominate and appoint Holmes H. Kress as such Executor and request the court to appoint him as such.
